## LEVEL 2 LICENSE



### Seg 1

- Segment 1 fee
- Minimum age of 14 years and 8 months
- 24 hours of classroom
- 6 hours behind the wheel
- 4 hours of observation
- Written exam

### Level 1

- Secretary of State fee
- Vision exam
- Written approval of parents
- May only drive with parent or designated licensed adult over the age of 21
- All driving hours up to minimum of 50 hours must be logged

### Seg 2

- 30 hours of the required 50 hours behind the wheel with parent, including 2 hours of the required 10 hours night driving
- Held a valid Level 1 license for a minimum of 3 consecutive months
- Segment 2 fee
- 6 hours of classroom
- Written exam

### Prep for RT

- Complete what remains of the required 50 hours behind the wheel: including what remains of the 10 hours required for night driving
- Review the [Driving Skills Test Study Guide](#)

### RT

- Road Test fee
- Minimum of 6 months at Level 1
- Parent/legal guardian
- Vehicle Inspection
- Basic Control Skills portion of test
- On-Road portion of the test

### Level 2

- No fee
- 16 years of age
- 90 days violation/ crash free driving prior to the application for Level 2 license
- Follow restrictions
